The kitchen shall contain a dining hall, a storeroom, a bedroom for the cook and two bathrooms. (One for the cook, and one for church members that will come for worship including visitors). The total cost from start to finish is: 4,500.00 (four thousand five hundred dollars). Please help!!

We need to separate the children from the adult class. We are aware this may take a longer time because it takes construction to achieve that. We need our prayers for this young congregation.
